

ROAD USER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, _____, variously known herein as contractor, company, or principal, desires to utilize the public roadway of Calcasieu Parish for hauling pursuant to operation involving _____;
and

WHEREAS, the roadway(s) involved are _____ road(s) located in Ward ____ of Calcasieu Parish; and,

WHEREAS, contractor, company or principal intends to commence use of the roadway on _____ date for an estimated period of _____ day(s);
and

WHEREAS, the use of the roadway may result in damage to the roadways listed hereinabove:

Therefore, the following conditions are to be adhered to:

1. A police escort is to accompany the move while on the Parish maintained highway system.
2. _____ to assume liability for any damages that may occur during the move.
3. Hauler should verify all horizontal and vertical clearances including lights, signals, signs, fixed trusses, load limits, etc., on the traveling route prior to the move.
4. On all roads, the hauling unit shall travel straddling the centerline of bridges and is not to exceed a crawling speed of 5 mph with no acceleration, braking, or shifting of gears.
5. No other commercial vehicle should travel on the bridge while the super-load crosses the structure.
6. The Parish is to be notified 24 hours prior to the move so that a representative qualified to assess any damage that may occur during the move.
7. **Failure to comply with any of the above requirements could result in further requests being denied.**

Principal also agrees herein immediately to notify the Calcasieu Parish Police Jury upon cessation of such use to enable an appropriate inspection with the purpose of assessing any damage as a result of said use.
