Sadonna came to the American Job Center to receive assistance to attend Academy of Acadiana for the medical assistant program. Sadonna felt like it was time for a career change and stepped out on faith to make it happen.

What services were received by the participant? (Include all relevant WIOA services.)

Sadonna went through the eligibility process where she had to bring in the proper documentation to determine her eligibility and then she was scheduled to take her CASA (reading and math assessment). Because she completed the eligibility and assessment portions successfully (basic skills deficient and SNAP recipient), and was deemed eligible to receive tuition assistance from WIOA, Sadonna was able to move on to case management to complete her paperwork for enrollment to attend Academy of Acadiana on July 25, 2022.

In what ways did the services help the participant achieve success? (Please be specific.)

Because Sadonna was able to receive tuition assistance from WIOA to attend school, she is now a Medical Assistant at Face Pace Urgent Care making \$12.75. She has growth aspirations in the medical field and is very hopeful about the growth opportunities that are available to her.
