- 1. Why is there a need to transfer funds? (Example: Economic conditions such as high/low unemployment, business closures, etc.) LWDA #51 served more Adults with Individual Training Accounts (ITA's) as well as support services, and On the job training which in turn resulted in the agency spending more in the Adult funding stream.
2. How will the transfer of funds affect the participant levels in both the Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs? Provide an estimated number of Adult and Dislocated Workers expected to be served if the transfer is granted. The transfer of funds from DW to Adult will allow LWDA 51 to serve more Adults in all of the programs that we offer which includes: OJT, Apprenticeship, Classroom Training, Work Experience, and the Supportive services associated with individuals that are in training. The transfer from DW to Adult will not affect the number of Dislocated Workers that can be enrolled, as we typically have more funding in the DW funding stream than in the Adult funding stream. We anticipate enrolling about 40 Adults into training and possibly 10 in Dislocated Worker. Historically, the DW population would rather get back to work, as opposed to sitting in a classroom setting.
3. Explain the impact on jointly funded employment and training programs in the Local Service Delivery System. Currently there are no jointly funded employment training programs in the Local Service Delivery System.
