 Gaming sector has rebounded to pre-COVID levels


 CPPJ Sales tax revenues and property tax revenues have been positive in 2023

 Federal recovery funds are beginning to flow through the local economy





#### Calcasieu Parish Police Jury 2023-2024 Budget Comparison (Net of Interfund Transfers)






#### Calcasieu Parish Police Jury Revenue Recap \$356,992,635



### Calcasieu Parish Police Jury 1.0 Cent Sales Tax Trend (Millions)











### POLICE JURY STRATEGIC PRIORITY

In 2018, the CPPJ initiated a strategic planning process that sought to answer the question: "What does the CPPJ need to do over the next three years to improve Calcasieu Parish for current residents and future generations to come?" Through this plan update process, the CPPJ again sought to answer the same question but through a different lens—one focused on the normal operations, programs, and services local government agencies must implement to serve their residents, but amidst a dramatically changed post-disaster, post-pandemic landscape.

It is through this lens that the Police Jury established this updated strategic priority framework – one that features slight but important modifications to the prior plan's priorities, along with the addition of a new, seventh strategic priority that specifically reinforces the CPPJ's prominent, sustained focus on long-term disaster recovery. Each priority represents an area of focus that will drive CPPJ programs, services, investments, and overall quality of life in Calcasieu Parish. These priorities are structured to serve as the basis upon which all major decisions are made over the next three years, including but not limited to department-level decision-making and parishwide budgeting.

Develop a framework and processes that lead to more efficient CPPJ operations, drive more effective and responsive services and programs, and maintain strong confidence in local government.

The CPPJ depends on and collaborates with a wide variety of entities to provide services to residents—often in varying ways that generate similarly varied outcomes. By establishing a framework and processes for how these collaborations unfold (both within the CPPJ and with external agencies), the CPPJ can be more consistent, intentional, and effective with its partnerships, allowing it to build on the trust it has established among residents and further maximize its impact.

2 Create, facilitate, and prioritize strong quality of life measures that make Calcasieu Parish a place that people can call home for years to come.

While the CPPJ's seven strategic priorities are not ordered based on relative priority, the Police Jury felt strongly enough about the importance of quality of life improvements that this priority should be closer to the beginning of the list. The impacts of recent disaster events, such as widespread debris and a decimated housing supply, have reframed how the parish thinks about quality of life; it is equal parts *wanting* to call Calcasieu Parish home and having the *ability* to call it home. The Police Jury is committed to advancing quality of life improvements today so that residents can begin to once again feel a sense of normalcy while setting the standard for what future quality of life looks like in Calcasieu Parish for years to come.

**3** Focus on long-term infrastructure needs and implement projects and initiatives that leverage partnerships and funding sources at all levels.

Infrastructure has been an ongoing focus for Calcasieu Parish over the years, but the lens through which it is viewed has changed. In recent years, infrastructure improvements were seen as vital to support a growing population and economy. After widespread damage to existing systems resulting from Hurricanes Laura and Delta that exposed






