Said project is located near Moss Bluff, Louisiana, at the intersection of Sutherland and Dunn Ferry Roads. The Planning Staff recommends that the Police Jury indicate no objection to this project application.
 - (15.2) Proposal of Ed Nelson, c/o Arabie Environmental Solutions, Inc., to clear, excavate, grade and place fill to construct house foundations,

driveways and roadways, all to develop a 127-lot residential subdivision (Inwood Forest II). Said project is located off Beglis Parkway in Sulphur, Louisiana. The Planning Staff recommends that the Police Jury indicate no objection to this project application.

<u>AGENDA NOTE</u>: The original permit was issued August 26, 1999, and the applicant is now requesting a time extension to complete Phase II of the subdivision.

(15.3) Proposal of Henry Misse, c/o Arabie Environmental Solutions, Inc., to clear, grub, grade, and redistribute native earthen material and deposit additional hauled in fill to construct house foundations, driveways, and roadways, all to develop a 27-lot residential subdivision (Sandia Estates). Said project is located on Currie Road, near Sulphur, Louisiana. The Planning Staff recommends that the Police Jury indicate no objection to this project application.

<u>AGENDA NOTE:</u> The original permit was issued on April 18, 2000, and the applicant is now requesting a time extension to complete Phase II of the subdivision.

16. Take appropriate action on ST-03-001-10 (Highway 397 and Highway 14) which is a request by the Calcasieu Parish Police Jury, Division of Planning and Development, to study the feasibility of reclassifying certain tracts of land in Ward Three near the intersection of Ward Line Road, Highway 397, and Highway 14 East from A-1 (Agricultural) to C-1 (Light Commercial). (Police Jury District 9, Mr. Guidry)

[The Planning and Zoning Board met on Tuesday, April 20, 2010, and voted unanimously to recommend that the request be granted.]

17. Consideration of adopting a resolution approving a Lease Agreement between the Police Jury and Mr. Dedrick L. Milburn and Ms. Deana A. Green, in the amount of \$100.00, for the property located at 9516 Simon LeBleu Drive, Lake Charles, LA, that was acquired through a flood mitigation grant and must remain "open space," and further, authorizing the President of the Police Jury, or his designee, to execute all documents related thereto. <u>AGENDA NOTE</u>: On February 18, 2010, the Police Jury approved a Lease Agreement with the original homeowners who have stated that they are no longer interested in leasing the property.
