Ashlee Guillory came to the American Job Center in seeking assistance for education and training that is in the dental assistant field. Ashlee had spoken with the youth staff about wanting to attend Academy of Acadiana for the Dental Assistant program which has been her interest for a long-term career. Ashlee was a 19-year-old out of school youth. Ashlee was eligible for the WIOA youth program due to the following by being a parenting youth, basic skills deficient in both Reading and Math, and living in a high poverty area. Ashlee started the Dental Assistant program at Academy of Acadiana on 03/06/2023 with a projected end date of April 27, 2023. During Ashlee's time enrolled in the WIOA youth program she attended class on time everyday for class with no absences. During Ashlee's time in school, she was an excellent student and has passed her exams and test. Ashlee did not receive any supportive services while she attended school for dental assistant. Ashlee completed the Dental Assistant program on May 19, 2023, by earning a certificate of completion from Academy of Acadiana. Ashlee was also able to gain employment at Aspen Dental as a Dental Assistant working full-time making \$15.00 an hour. Ashlee was grateful that the WIOA youth program was able to help with her schooling, so that she can get started in her career as a dental assistant and later in the future would like to further her education in the dental field.
