

Entrance to Secure Holding Area-

Area is where youth that have been transported by Law Enforcement wait for their parents arrival

Screening Rooms-

In these rooms staff members meet with families and discuss the diversion process.

If the family agrees to Diversion, staff members interviews the family and administers the JIFF- Juvenile Inventory for Functioning (Primary) screening instrument.

If further screening is required staff also may administer the:

MAYSI- Massachusetts Youth Screening Instrument (Secondary)

SASSI- Substance Abuse Subtile Screening Inventory (Secondary)

Conference Room-

Area were staff members meet with families to conduct the Intake to address problems, and create a case plan.

Counseling Room-

Area where the counselor meets with the youth and family to work as a team to assess problem situations, family, emotional, behavioral, mental health, and other needs identified by the screening instruments administered, engage in crisis stabilization and resolution, and develop a plan of action in supporting the family.

Conference Room-

Area were staff members meet with families to conduct the Intake to address problems, and create a case plan.

Staff Office-

Staff space is dynamic. It allows for multi-agency sharing and collaboration.
