- B. 20% must Represent

1. **Labor Organizations** Nominated by Local Labor Federations
2. a Representative Who Is a Member of a **Labor Organization or a Training Director** from a Joint Labor-management Org. Such as an Apprenticeship Program
3. May include reps of **community-based orgs.** that have demonstrated expertise in addressing the employment needs of **individuals with barriers** to employment, including organization that serve **veterans** or provide or support competitive integrated employment for individuals with disabilities.
4. May include organization that have demonstrated experience and expertise in addressing the employment, training or education needs of eligible youth, including reps of organizations that **serve out-of-school youth.**

- C. Representatives of entities administering education & training activities in the local area who

- i. Include a rep of eligible providers of **adult education & literacy**
- ii. Include a rep of **institutions of higher education providing workforce investment activities (community colleges)**
- iii. Include reps of local educational agencies & community-based orgs with demonstrated experience and expertise in **addressing the education and training needs of individuals with barriers to employment**

- D. Reps of economic & community development entities

- i. A rep of **economic & community development entities**
- ii. Include an appropriate rep from the **State employment service office under the Wagner Peyser Act** serving the local area
- iii. Include an appropriate rep of the programs carried out under title I on the **Rehabilitation Act** serving the local area
- iv. May include reps of agencies or entities administering programs serving the local area relating to **transportation, housing & public assistance**
- v. may include reps of **philanthropic organizations** serving the local area

- E. Other such individuals or reps of entities as the CEO in the local area may determine to be appropriate

Chairperson: must be from the reps described above in paragraph 2A
