



## STORM WATER PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

**\*\*Permits are required prior to beginning any work\*\***

### **Small Construction Sites (less than 1 acre)—not part of a larger development**

(No permit from DEQ required)

- CPPJ Permit
- Stormwater Erosion and Sediment Control Plan ([Showing Best Management Practices](#))

### **Small Construction Sites (1 to less than 5 acres)**

(DEQ Stormwater General Permit---[LAR200000](#))---No DEQ Permit Fee

- CPPJ Permit
- [Stormwater Erosion and Sediment Control Plan \(Showing Best Management Practices\)](#)
- Develop a [Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan](#)
  - ✓ Post of notice at construction site noting location of **SWPPP**, name, telephone #, LPDES Permit #, brief description of project
  - ✓ Update and change plan as situations change on site
  - ✓ Must be kept current with periodic inspections of site
- Submit a [Completion Report](#) to DEQ (when site has been stabilized)

### **Construction Activities of 5 Acres or More**

(DEQ Stormwater General Permit ---[LAR100000](#)) ---Permit Fee is \$264.00—sent to DEQ

- CPPJ Permit
- [Stormwater Erosion and Sediment Control Plan \(Showing Best Management Practices\)](#)
- Develop a [Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan](#)
  - ✓ Post of notice at construction site noting location of **SWPPP**, contact name, telephone #, LPDES permit #, brief description of project
  - ✓ Update and change plan as situations change on site
  - ✓ Must be kept current with periodic inspections of site
- File **Notice of Intent (NOI)** at least 48 hrs prior to construction activity—sent to DEQ
- File **Notice of Termination (NOT)**---after project is complete or when area has been stabilized. (70% density cover)—sent to DEQ
