Environmental Permit Requirements

** Permits are required prior to beginning any work**

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act, as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251 <u>et seq.</u>), and the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act, as amended (La. R. S. 30:2001 <u>et seq.</u>), the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) requires that both small and large construction site operators obtain the applicable storm water permit(s) for their site(s):

Large developments of greater than five (5) acres require application to the LDEQ for and receipt of the Storm Water General Permit for Construction Activity Five (5) Acres or more (<u>LAR100000</u>). Operators of large development sites shall comply with the requirements of the permit including submittal of a <u>Notice of Intent</u> to the LDEQ.

Small developments of from one (1) to five (5) acres shall comply with the requirements of the Storm Water General Permit for Small Construction Activities (LAR200000).
